Draw a picture below to go with it.






Things will change a lot in 100 years. What do you think the world will be like? What cool inventions will there be? Draw a picture and write about the world 100 years into the future.

Celebrate the 100th day of school by reading one or more books from RIF's 100 day of school collection.




