



Reading Crown!

Materials:

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• Glue or tape, scissors

Instructions:

1. Cut out each section.

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- 2. Tape or glue the flat edged peices together. One end will have the pointed edge, and the other end will be the T shape.
- 3. Wrap the crown around a child's head and then fold the ends of the T down on the inside of the crown. Tape or glue to reinforce the strap of the crown.




- 1. Provided are a number of downloadable coloring sheets.

- 4. Have your students stand in front of their very own Rally to Read 'step and repeat' banner and take pictures.








